



It is possible to insert bicones, faceted, bugle and fancy beads in netting.


Do not use too big beads for decoration because the diamond cells would be at risk to get distorted, beads of 4 or 6 mm are good With seed beads 11/0 netting.


Start weaving downwards as shown on picture A, that is the sample of using faceted beads. Those faceted beads will also play a role of additional corner beads.

I add a picot of 3 seed beads at the end of the row here and further, but you may find other ideas.

Go upwards and finish the row as shown on picture B.

If you want you can use seed beads of different color before and after each faceted bead, it is your personal choice.






Picture C displays a part of netting that will be woven using seed beads with a faceted bead inserted.


Pattern D shows you the number of beads to thread before and after the faceted bead. Turn normally at the bottom and go upward.

Do not hesitate to make some rows as a test before you start your piece.




Whatever decoration beads you use, you have to thread the same number of beads on either side of the axis, that will let you reach the proper pattern and shape while weaving.

You may also thread the decoration beads elsewhere. In the example on the right, corner seed beads (red on the first picture) are replaced with bugle beads (on the middle picture), and with 1 seed bead + 1 bugle bead + 1 seed bead (on the third picture). Any combination is possible, it is up to you!



You may also add decoration beads in your "increases" and "decreases". As you can see on the pictures below, numerous choices remain possible, it only requires that you take care of the decoration beads size.

Once your jewel is finished, you may add extra seed beads between "increase" or "decrease" diamond cells (they are in red on the pattern herebellow).






HOW TO EMBROIDER YOUR NETTING AFTER WEAVING

Once you finish your netting piece of jewelry, you may embroider it using seed beads of another size, bicones, faceted, bugle and fancy beads.

My advice is the same: make sure you don't take too big decoration beads that could warp your netting weaving.



You need to pass through the corner bead, take a decoration bead and pass through another corner bead when going downwards, and pass through woven beads when going upwards as shown on the picture. Depending on the decoration beads size, you may sometimes need to insert supplementary small seed beads before or after, or both, each decoration bead. Watch out what would be the best fit for your diamond cells in case of your particular choice.
